The Magic of Puppets & Storytelling

Beginning in November and December, our programs with have an opportunity to experience puppets and storytelling with Lindsay.

More than just fun, using puppets and crafting stories with young children is a rich, holistic experience that significantly supports development across many domains. It is a beautiful way to see our children flourish as "mighty learners and citizens," perfectly aligning with FLIGHT: Alberta's Early Learning and Care Framework.

Puppets offer children a safe and engaging platform to explore complex ideas and emotions.

Emotional & Social Growth:

Puppets can act out feelings (sadness, anger, joy) in a low-stakes way, helping children develop emotional literacy and empathy. When a puppet faces a problem—like having to wait for a turn—children are encouraged to brainstorm solutions, fostering social skills, problem-solving, and communication.

Language & Literacy:

Through dialogue and narrative, children expand their vocabulary, practice active listening, and develop an understanding of story structure. For shy children, speaking through a puppet can build confidence and expressive language skills.

Creativity & Imagination:

Creating and performing a puppet show encourages imaginative play, as children invent characters, settings, and plots, exercising their innate curiosity and creative thinking.

Multiculturalism and the Holidays — Sparking Curiosity in Programs

It's important to create an environment where all of the children feel welcome and represented. While teaching a multicultural curriculum may not be too challenging most of the year, December brings the holidays, when one or two holidays are usually much more visible than the others.

If done well, an inclusive holiday celebration can help children learn about diversity. Each child and their family will celebrate the holidays differently. Although not everyone who celebrates Christmas associates the holiday with its religious origins, it's important to keep in mind that by

choosing to celebrate only certain holidays, you could be excluding some of the families. In other words, if you'll be celebrating Christmas, make sure to carve out equal time during the year to devote to all holidays of major importance. It's also important to keep in mind that some religions do not celebrate any holidays, such as Jehovah's and Seventh Day Adventists.

When you're exposing children to cultural traditions they may not be familiar with (and which you may not be either), it's important to avoid cliches and harmful stereotypes.

Just like no two families who celebrate Christmas are exactly alike, the same goes for those who celebrate non-Christian holidays. So do your research and talk with the families about what and how they celebrate the holiday season.
