

## Cost Control Framework and For-Profit Expansion Plan

In January 2023, Alberta and Canada announced the Cost Control Framework and For-Profit Expansion Plan (CCF). The CCF provides a model to move from an ELCC system primarily funded by parent fees to one primarily funded by government. The CCF ensures child care operators, agencies and educators have access to funding supports to continue to provide

quality child care that Albertans expect while reducing parent fees and ensuring reasonable use of public funds.

#### Proposed principles of the ELCC funding formula approach:

Accessibility: Families have options for ELCC where and when they need it.

**Quality:** Early childhood educators deliver highquality ELCC programs that support children's well-being and developmental needs.

Affordability: Sustained affordable child care supports families and ultimately Alberta's economic prosperity.

**Inclusivity:** A connected community of partners supports safe, high-quality and inclusive ELCC.

**Fiscal Sustainability:** ELCC system is designed

and allocated public funds to ensure the viability of a high-quality ELCC system, in alignment to the CCF, while ensuring the sound and reasonable use of public funds.

Sector Stability: A transparent and equitable funding formula for Alberta's mixed market ELCC system ensures a stable and sustainable transition and future for ELCC in Alberta.

## Implementation Timelines for the \$10/day Care

A detailed Implementation Plan outlining a sustainable transition for the ELCC sector will be developed following feedback gathered during engagements, transition to the ELCC funding formula approach is anticipated by 2025-2026. As part of the transition to the ELCC funding formula approach, the ministry may consider changes to the way ELCC grants are administered. This would further streamline funding processes, creating efficiency,

- consistency and reducing administrative burden for operators, agencies and educators.
- January 2024: Increase affordability grants to achieve an average \$15 per day, parents will pay a minimum of \$217.50 a month for care services before subsidy is deducted.
- Summer 2024 Early 2025: Pilot the new ELCC funding formula for select child care operators, if your program is selected they will notify you of being part of the pilot.

• By 2025 – 2026: Implement a sustainable transition to the new ELCC funding formula for remaining child care operators.

In the future \$10 per day model, optional services offered at an additional parent fee may only be for services not deemed essential to child care delivery as outlined in the Early Learning and Child Care Act and Regulations and Family Day Home Standards Manual.

#### School-Aged Children

The Agreement provides funding for children from 0 to kindergarten-age. As such, the ELCC funding formula approach will apply to eligible licensed child care programs and spaces in Alberta that provide care to infants, toddlers, and preschoolaged children, including children who attend kindergarten part-time (i.e. fewer than five full days per week) and require child care during regular school hours.

Programs and spaces that provide care to children attending kindergarten full-time and to children in Grades 1 to 6 are not included in funding under the Agreement.
